***Saving Jesus from the Church***  
by Rev. Dr. Robin Meyers

Countless thoughtful people are now so disgusted with the marriage of bad theology and hypocritical behavior by the church that a new Reformation is required in which the purpose of religion itself is reimagined.

Meyers takes the best of biblical scholarship and recasts these core Christian concepts to exhort the church to pursue an alternative vision of the Christian life. This is not a call to the church to move to the far left or to try something brand new. Rather, it is the recovery of something very old. *Saving Jesus from the Church* shows us what it means to be a Christian and how to follow Jesus' teachings today.

**From Jesus to NCC: How We Got From Then to Now ~ Led by Dick Watts**  
Sunday mornings at 9am

Probably most of us in NCC regard church history as not only boring but depressing. We admire Jesus, but not Christianity. We figure that Jesus got it right, and then everything went downhill - from Constantine to popes, Crusades and Inquisition. So we tend to feel like spiritual orphans, starting from scratch.

But that's a skewed view. The reality is that in every generation there have been NCCs - communities of people trying to do in their time what Jesus did in his, loving God and neighbor, being part of the healing of the world. In this class we'll explore that less-known history, using Diana Butler Bass' book, *A People's History of Christianity: The Other Side of the Story*.

In her reader-friendly book, Bass challenges our "spiritual amnesia:" "Without a sense of history, progressive Christianity remains unmoored, lacking the deep confidence that comes from being part of a community over time."

***Soul of a Citizen: Living With Conviction in a Cynical Time*** by Paul Loeb

A book of inspiration and integrity, *Soul of a Citizen* is an antidote to the twin scourges of modern life-powerlessness and cynicism. In his evocative style, Paul Loeb tells moving stories of ordinary Americans who have found unexpected fulfillment in social involvement. Through their example and Loeb's own wise and powerful lessons, we are compelled to move from passivity to participation. The reward of our action, we learn, is nothing less than a sense of connection and purpose not found in a purely personal life.
